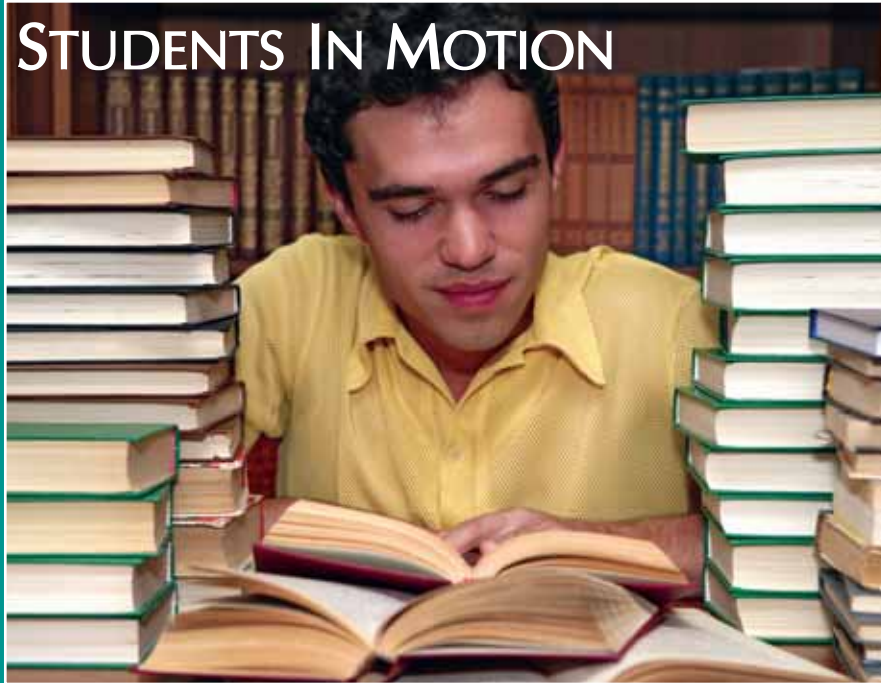

Chamber to offer scholarship to high school seniors

In an effort to support the children of our community, the Lee's Summit Chamber has established a scholarship fund for graduating seniors.

The Chamber designated \$25,000 of non-dues revenue reserves to the Chamber Scholarship Fund established at the Eastland Community Foundation. Dollars in the reserves are available due to the successes of recent Oktoberfests and other fund-raising events, and allows the Chamber the opportunity to give back to the community.

Students eligible for assistance shall be graduating seniors intending to continue their education through a two or four year college and/or technical school. The scholarship will be supplemental for students who have already earned athletic and/or academic scholarships. Applicants must have a parent or guardian currently working for an organization that is a member in good standing with the Lee's Summit Chamber of Commerce.

The one-time scholarship is \$1,000 and will be selected by the Lee's Summit Chamber Education Committee based on GPA, work and community service, and a completed application.

Applications are available at the Chamber office. Deadline for submittal is March 16, 2007. Finalists for the scholarship may be interviewed. Information on how other businesses can donate to the fund will be available soon.

The Lee's Summit Chamber of Commerce is calling for nominations for the "2007 Res In Motus Business of the Year Awards." For the first time, the Chamber is recognizing four separate award categories that best represent business in motion. (Entrepreneur) Vegrandis, (Small) Parvus, (Medium) Medius, and (Large) Magnus.

In the past, the Chamber has recognized one Small Business of the Year. Because the Chamber is represented by a wide range of businesses and many businesses do not fit the "small business" category, a new format will be implemented for the 2007 Awards that will include ALL members.

Criteria for the Awards include:

- *Lee's Summit Chamber member in good standing*
 - *in business a minimum of three years*
 - *a commitment to good business practice*
 - *growth in number of employees and/or sales*
 - *service to the community and to the Chamber*
 - *a history of good employee relations*
- Companies may nominate themselves.

Previous Small Business of the Year winners from the past five years are not eligible.

Deadline for nominations is **January 19**.

Nominations must be returned to the Chamber office, 220 SE Main, Lee's Summit, Mo. 64063, by January 19.

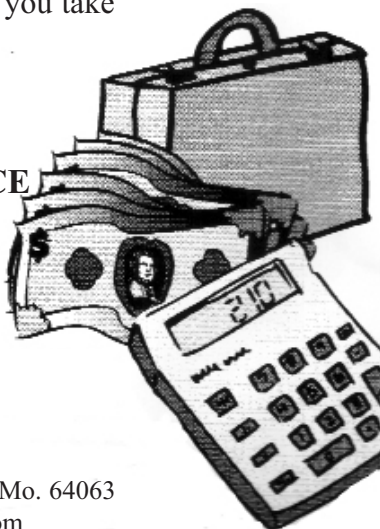
